When God Gives Growth

"But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers." Psalm 1:2-3 (ESV)

I recently experienced one of those small but wonderful works of God. I picked an orange from one of the trees in my backyard, which may have been the best orange I had ever tasted. It was plump, full of pulp, and as sweet as candy. In a word, it was terrific. I was so excited! I couldn't have said this two years ago because my orange trees were asleep. Because my trees weren't bearing fruit, I shared with a family friend, Eric, that our trees weren't doing so well. He explained that they will go to sleep when a tree does not get enough water, fertilizer, or sunlight. They are still fruit trees and still have the potential to bear fruit, but they lack the nutrients that allow them to prosper. Thankfully, he added a drip system, pruned them back, and measured out fertilizer. He said, "Fruit trees will sleep, creep, and then leap." If you give them what they need to grow, they will creep forward with branches and leaves and then take a giant leap in producing fruit! Well, that has happened, and I am now fully stocked with fantastic oranges.

I have seen the same thing happening with our ministry here at SMCC. I am acutely aware that we cannot force fruit to develop, but we can cultivate an environment where an abundance blossoms. It is not easy to nurture spiritual growth, but it is amazing when it comes to fruition. Prayer and applying God's Word to our lives takes discipline but increases our faith. Seeking God and his resources to endure adversity requires faith and an intentional choice of the will. Memorizing scripture so we can easily access God's insight when life needs more of us than we think we can give is arduous. Planning, setting goals, and creating strategic steps are often never seen by others and seldom are rewarding in the short run. Beginning everything in prayer often goes unnoticed and taken for granted in the same way we assume the sun will shine again tomorrow, just as it has every day of our lives. Can you imagine, however, if these unseen steps were not being taken?

I'm grateful that Women's Ministry had such a fruitful year because you and many faithful women served, prayed, encouraged, discipled, taught, worked behind the scenes, and invited families to SMCC! Many ladies surrendered their lives to Christ, got baptized, were discipled, and became part of the SMCC family. God has faithfully grown his church through Girl Time, Coffee Connect, Global Connect, Bible studies, and Active Groups. We are rejoicing over the 1600 women participating in weekly Bible studies and Active Groups. Women are being watered through the Word! Women have come alongside Women's Ministries and lovingly connected women to God, His Word, and others who will help them grow.

We know we didn't produce the fruit, but I am so proud of all the people who helped create an environment where the fruit could grow. As Paul wrote, "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth." (1 Corinthians 3:6)

Please pray that Colossians 1:10-12 is the reality of our ministry this year so we can "walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light."

Watchman, let's pray this will be a year in which God will bear much fruit! The harvest is plentiful!
