The Watchman

The prayer ministry we are involved with as a "watchman" is titled "Watchman on the Wall." The word "watchman" appears multiple times in the Bible according to my research, particularly in the book of Ezekiel. In Ezekiel 3:17 we learn that God appointed Ezekiel as a watchman for the house of Israel. The verse reads, "Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore, hear a word from My mouth, and give them warning from Me."

According to W.A. Criswell's study Bible, "Ezekiel's unique ministry to Israel was to be a divinely appointed "watchman," one who not only warned the nation, but also issued directed warnings to individuals. It was the duty of the watchman to scan the horizon and sound the alarm for any impending danger." To that description Criswell then adds this, "A man measures his responsibility by his knowledge and opportunities. Thus, the "watchman" carried an awesome responsibility."

As a "Watchman" at Shadow Mountain Community Church, we have been given a challenging and awesome responsibility. Each month our Pastoral staff updates the critical prayer needs for their ministry and we are dependent upon each "Watchman" to diligently beseech the "throne of grace" to ask God for His guidance and favor in our ministries. We are grateful for your commitment to faithfully pray and fulfill your role as "watchman."

In Psalm 130:5-6, the Psalmist uses the imagery of a watchman awaiting the morning to express the longing for God's salvation. He writes, "I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in His word I do hope. My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning—Yes, more than those who watch for the morning." Here we find the Psalmist testifying that he waits patiently for the Lord. He compares his wait to that of a city's watchman looking for the first rays of dawn, for then they would be relieved of their duties by other guards.

As we pass the watchman role to the one who comes after us on the wall, let's fulfill our responsibility by joyously passing the responsibility. And may you find rejoicing in your own heart as you realize once again you fulfilled your role as a "Watchman" for the ministries of Shadow Mountain Community Church.
